

# DEEP VEIN THROMBOSIS

Health Care Providers (HCPs)

## DVT Risk Stratification (Wells Score)

Clinical Characteristic	Points
Active cancer (chemotherapy within 6 months or current palliative care)	1
Paralysis, paresis, or recent plaster cast immobilization of the lower extremity	1
Recently bedridden for 3+ days, or major surgery within prior 12 weeks requiring general or regional anesthesia	1
Localized tenderness along deep vein distribution	1
Entire leg swollen	1
Calf swelling $\geq 3$ cm more than asymptomatic leg (measure 10cm below tibial tuberosity)	1
Pitting edema confined to symptomatic leg	1
Collateral superficial veins visible (non-varicose)	1
Previously documented DVT	1
Alternative diagnosis at least as likely as DVT	-2

### A score of $\leq 0$

Low Pretest Probability

### A score of 1-2

Moderate Pretest Probability

### A score of $\geq 3$

High Pretest Probability

#### DVT: Deep Vein Thrombosis

Pretest Probability: Likelihood of a DVT diagnosis before lab tests or imaging studies are performed
